- ⑤ Be a qualified teacher in education or undergoing training to become qualified or hold an NNEB qualification
- ⑤ Hold the Pool Emergency Procedures or acceptable equivalent

- ⑤ Aquatic Activities - Water Polo, Synchronised Swimming (optional)
- ⑤ Aquatic Games/Aquatic Fun Races (optional)
- ⑤ School Galas - Set-up, Races, Programming (optional)
- ⑤ Survival and Rescue Skills (optional)

(One of the optional topics will be chosen by the course organiser to meet the requirements of the candidates and school)
